

Application Period

Fall Semester

30th March - 01st June 2024

14th Oct - 15th Nov 2024

Registration Instructions

The student will receive the Loyola credentials in July and the link to make the official Registration of courses.

At the end of the registration the student must pay 80€ which includes:

- Accident in campus insurance
- Loyola student card
- Delivery of Transcript of Records
- Administrative fee

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT FOR STUDYING IN LOYOLA


English

Spanish

B1 certificate will be **mandatory** if the student intends **to enroll classes in Spanish.**

A free Spanish language course of one week (1 ECTS/10h) during the welcome week


Extensive Course



LOYOLA FAQ'S

- **Can students take courses from different areas of study?**

Yes, but the student will need to check if they have the proper knowledge to follow the classes successfully. Please check the syllabus.

- **Can students take master courses?**

Undergraduate programs in Loyola are 4 years. Master students from other universities are advised to take 3- 4 year courses.

- **Are classes taught bilingually?**

No, there are classes in Spanish and classes in English. The student will need to enroll in the classes that they are able to follow and present the exams in the corresponding language.

- **Do you send exams to be done at the home university?**

No, exams are done face to face. There will not be any virtual exams either.
